Steps	Things that will happen if you make ' <i>wrong</i> ' choices
1	▪ Your teacher will explain to you why what you are doing is wrong.
2	▪ Your teacher will tell you again that your behaviour is wrong.
3	▪ You will have 5 minutes thinking time.
4	▪ You will have 10 minutes thinking time in another class.
5	▪ A note will go home in your planner.
6	▪ Your teacher will talk to your parents about your behaviour.
7	▪ Your teacher will have a meeting with your parents. This is now serious .
8	▪ Your teacher and parents will have a meeting with Mr. Kevin. This is very serious .
9	▪ Your parents will have a meeting with Mr. Kevin and Ms. Chloe. This is extremely serious . You will work in another room for one or two days and will be away from your friends.
10	▪ Your parents will have a meeting with Ms. Chloe. You will not come to school for two days. You should change your behaviour now.
11	▪ Your parents and Ms. Chloe will have a meeting with Ms. Sharon. You will not come to school for three days. You will have to find a new school.
12	▪ Your parents will have a meeting with Ms. Sharon. You will have to find a new school.
