Registers	The class registers are taken at 07:10. Children arriving after this time will receive a 'Signed in at the Office' slip and will be marked in late. This is to ensure our children are kept safe and our registers are accurate in the case of an emergency. It is imperative that children arrive to school on time.
Late Pick Up	If your child is collected late from school, you will be asked to scan them out on your arrival. Serial late collection will result in charges in line with our Late Collection Policy. This is available to read on our Website.
Year 1 to 6 After School Club	Our After School Club is led by our Teaching Assistants. It runs from 14:00 until 15:00. This is a payable service. For more details, please see Ms. Dema in the office.
Extra-Curricular Activities	Extra-curricular activities are run by Teachers and outside agencies after school from 14:00 – 15:00. Some require additional payment. More information regarding these clubs will be shared with you shortly.
Drop Off & Pick Up	We ask that you drop off your child at the white gates. At pick up time, please collect your child from their classroom door. In the cooler months, the children will wait in the playground to be collected. Once you have collected your child it is extremely important that you leave the school premises. Playing in the playground is not permitted.
