


## Whole School Arabic B Overview

### Year 1 Arabic B Yearly Overview

Year 1 Unit Breakdown		
1	<b>Meeting Friends</b> This unit will teach students how to greet each other. They will learn simple words and phrases which they can use around Qatar.	
2	<b>Colours All Around</b> During this unit, students will learn various colours and how to comment if they like or dislike certain colours. They will play simple games to reinforce this new vocabulary.	
3	<b>Beginning to Count</b> In this unit, students will learn to count to 10. They will play simple number games to reinforce this new vocabulary.	
4	<b>Which Day?</b> During this unit, students will learn the days of the week. They will play simple games to reinforce this new vocabulary.	
5	<b>A Visit to the Farm</b> This unit will teach students the vocabulary for various farm animals. Students will use their previous knowledge of colour to describe these animals.	
6	<b>Our Emotions are Important</b> During this unit, students will be able to describe their own feelings and emotions. They will consider what makes them happy and sad.	


## Year 2 Arabic B Yearly Overview

Year 2 Unit Breakdown		
1	<b>Everyday Conversations</b> In this unit, students will revise how to greet each other. They will then learn how to exchange names, ask how someone is, and say how old they are.	
2	<b>Counting On</b> In this unit, students will revise how to count to 10. They will then learn to count on to 20. They will play simple number games to reinforce this new vocabulary.	
3	<b>Months of the Year</b> During this unit, students revise the days of the week. They will then learn the months of the year. They will play simple games to reinforce this new vocabulary.	
4	<b>Where is the Rain?</b> In this unit, students will learn how to describe the weather. They will take on the role of weather reporters, reporting the current weather from various locations around the world.	
5	<b>Move Your Body</b> During this unit, students will learn key vocabulary for various body parts. They will learn action songs to reinforce this new vocabulary.	
6	<b>I'm Going to the Zoo</b> This unit will teach students the vocabulary for various zoo animals. Students will use their previous knowledge to count and describe these animals.	

## Year 3 Arabic B Yearly Overview

Year 3 Unit Breakdown		
1	<b>Getting to Know You</b> This unit will teach students about basics of the Arabic language. Students will revise concepts from Milepost 1 including how to greet each other, exchanging names, asking how someone is, counting to 20 and saying how old they are.	
2	<b>All About Me</b> During this unit, students will apply previous knowledge of topic areas such as naming parts of the body and identifying colours. They will then learn how to follow instructions and say what they are wearing.	
3	<b>Food, Glorious Food</b> This unit will teach students the vocabulary for a range of food items. They will learn how to express their likes and dislikes and use plural nouns.	
4	<b>Family &amp; Friends</b> This unit will teach students how to identify and introduce family and pets. They will also learn the names for places in their own home.	
5	<b>Our School</b> This unit will teach students key vocabulary and phrases on the theme of school. Students will learn vocabulary for the different areas around school as well as common classroom objects. They will learn to express preferences about activities and school subjects.	
6	<b>Time</b> During this unit, students will revise the days of the week and months. They will learn how to say different dates and also count from 20 to 40.	

## Year 4 Arabic B Yearly Overview

Year 4 Unit Breakdown		
1	<b>All Around Town</b> During this unit, students will learn to develop their cultural understanding by being introduced to sights of some typical Middle Eastern cities. They will also learn to describe places in a town, count to 100 and give their address in Arabic.	
2	<b>On the Move</b> In this unit, students will learn to develop their conversational skills through some new topics: transport, direction and movement. They will be able to name some types of transport and be able to follow simple directions.	
3	<b>Going Shopping</b> During this unit, students will learn specific vocabulary of fruit, vegetables and clothes. They will learn key phrases for asking the questions needed when going shopping. The unit concludes with a role play lesson, where students will take on the roles of shoppers and shopkeepers.	
4	<b>Where in the World?</b> In this unit, students will learn specific vocabulary related to countries of the Middle East, animals from different continents and a country's position related to the equator. They will join two simple sentences together to make a compound sentence.	
5	<b>What's the Time?</b> During this unit, students will learn how to tell the time: o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. This unit will be drawn together with a final lesson which is a mathematics lesson, calculating the difference between two times.	
6	<b>Holidays &amp; Hobbies</b> In this unit, students will learn key vocabulary related to holidays, weather and seasons, sports and hobbies. They will learn specific vocabulary of how to say what the weather is like, temperatures, names of different sports and hobbies. They will learn key phrases connected to the themes.	

## Year 5 Arabic B Yearly Overview

Year 5 Unit Breakdown		
1	<p><b>Pleased to Meet You</b></p> <p>In this unit, students will apply previous skills and knowledge from Milepost 2. They will then learn to express their emotions and talk about the future.</p>	
2	<p><b>All About Ourselves</b></p> <p>During this unit, children will apply previous knowledge of topic areas such as clothes and the body, developing vocabulary at the same time. They will learn to describe their own appearance to each other.</p>	
3	<p><b>That's Tasty!</b></p> <p>In this unit, students will learn key vocabulary related to food and drink. They will learn specific vocabulary for how to say what drinks they like, what they like to eat for breakfast, fillings for sandwiches, toppings for pizzas, what snacks they like and also the opening and closing time of shops.</p>	
4	<p><b>Family &amp; Friends</b></p> <p>During this unit, students will apply previous knowledge and skills of topic areas such as animals, homes and family to extend their conversation abilities. They will expand their vocabulary and consolidate their understanding of descriptive language.</p>	
5	<p><b>School Life</b></p> <p>In this unit, students will learn key vocabulary related to objects, subjects and prepositional language. It includes a Maths lesson which teaches the students the names of 2D shapes. Students will learn questions and answers which they would commonly use at school. They will learn key phrases connected to the themes.</p>	
6	<p><b>Time Travelling</b></p> <p>During this unit, students will apply previous knowledge and skills of topic areas such as numbers and dates. They will learn how to give dates of birth and today's date.</p>	

## Year 6 Arabic B Yearly Overview

Year 6 Unit Breakdown		
1	<p><b>Let's Order</b></p> <p>In this unit, students will review key vocabulary related to food and drink. They will learn key phrases and questions required when ordering food in a restaurant. The unit concludes with a role play lesson, where children will take on the roles of waiters and customers.</p>	
2	<p><b>Let's Explore Qatar</b></p> <p>In this unit, students will apply previous skills and knowledge of topic areas such as places in a town, directions, homes and numbers to develop their speaking and listening abilities.</p>	
3	<p><b>Let's Go Shopping</b></p> <p>During this unit your class will learn about the shopping experience in Arabic countries. They will learn key phrases for asking the questions needed when going shopping. The unit concludes with a role play lesson, where children will take on the roles of shoppers and shopkeepers.</p>	
4	<p><b>This is the Middle East</b></p> <p>In this unit, students will learn key vocabulary related to the Middle East and, in particular, Qatar. Students will learn specific vocabulary to describe Qatar's neighbours and positions/distances of a variety of cities. They will learn the Arabic names for different landmarks and how to describe what people do when they visit Qatar.</p>	
5	<p><b>All in a Day</b></p> <p>During this unit, your students will learn how to tell the time: o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to and 5-minute intervals. They will learn how to use 24-hour times.</p>	
6	<p><b>Look How Far I Have Come</b></p> <p>During this unit, students will revisit key concepts from Milepost 3. They will use ICT to demonstrate their new skills and knowledge.</p>
