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Uniform Policy

At Al Wataniya International School, we want our children to look smart when at school and feel proud to wear their school uniform. We have high standards and expectations and this is reflected in the pride we take in our school uniform. Not only do uniforms help to create a sense of community but also a feeling of belonging.

Aims:

- To maintain a strong sense of identity, pride and belonging within our school
- To promote consistently high standards of behaviour, attitude and dress.
- To avoid unnecessary clothing expense for parents.

Uniform:

Main Uniform

- White school polo shirt
- Navy shorts or trousers
- Navy skirt, pinafore or skort
- Navy and white checked dress during the summer
- Navy school jumper
- Black shoes with white socks

PE Uniform (To be worn on PE days only)

- Navy blue school PE t-shirt
- White shorts
- Navy tracksuit bottoms (optional)
- Navy school jumper
- Trainers with white socks

House Team Uniform (To be worn on House Competition Days only)

- House coloured polo shirt
- White shorts
- Navy school jumper
- Trainers with white socks

Some children choose to wear shorts or leggings under their skirt, dress or shorts for modesty. These should be plain navy or white.

Hair styles should be neat and tidy and promote our high standards of dress. Long hair should be off the face in all lessons and fully tied back for PE.

Nail varnish, make up and jewellery is not acceptable. Children may wear small, plain stud earrings on non-PE days.

Students will be encouraged to:

- Wear the correct uniform as described above.
- Remove jewellery or accessories that are not part of the uniform.
- Wear our uniform with pride.

Staff will always:

- Set a good example in terms of professional dress.
- Be discrete when discussing uniform concerns with the child.
- Contact parents regarding uniform concerns.
- Communicate recurring uniform concerns with Deputy Head Pastoral
- Promote smart dress.

Parents will be encouraged to:

- Ensure their child adheres to the uniform policy.
- Label all belongings clearly with the child's name and class.
- Work cooperatively with Class Teacher and Senior Leadership Team.
- Inform the class teacher if their child is not wearing the correct uniform for any reason.

The Leadership Team will:

- Implement the school uniform policy consistently throughout the school.
- Celebrate examples of exemplary dress with the whole school.
- Support the staff in implementing the uniform policy.
