Steps	Things that will happen if you make ' <i>wrong</i> ' choices
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your teacher will explain to you why what you are doing is wrong.
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your teacher will remind you that your behaviour is not acceptable.
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will be instructed to take 5 minutes away from classmates to think about your actions.
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will be instructed to take 10 minutes away from the classroom to think about your actions.
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A note will be written in your ISR and planner. Your parents will be asked to sign, saying that they have read the note in your planner.
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your teacher will call or speak face to face with your parents. They will tell them about your unacceptable behaviour in school. A note will be written in your ISR.
7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your teacher will call your parents in for a meeting with your Milepost Leader. A verbal warning will be given and a note will be written in your ISR. This is now serious.
8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your teacher and parents will have a meeting with your Milepost Leader. A note will be written in your ISR. This is very serious.
9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your Milepost Leader and parents will have a meeting with Deputy Head Pastoral. A written warning will be given and a note written in your ISR. You will be removed from class for up to two days. This is now extremely serious.
10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your parents will have a meeting with Deputy Head Pastoral. A second written warning will be given and a note written in your ISR. You will be removed from school for up to two days. You must change your behaviour immediately.
11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your parents and Deputy Head will have a meeting with the Principal. A final written warning will be given and you will be removed from school for up to three days.
12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your parents will have a meeting with the Principal. There will not be a place at AWIS for you next academic year.

Serious behaviour issues include: fighting, bullying, being aggressive to others, vandalism and stealing. They will be dealt with on an individual basis.
